## Services for July

July 7th, 10 am, "Book Roundup" led by Barbara Bogart.

We'll share our reading choices over the past year and consider the personal pleasures of reading. Bring a book or two you are willing to share for our book swap.

July 14<sup>th</sup>, 10 am, "We are Our Stories" roundtable discussion led by Jeff Lockwood. If people are the stories they tell themselves and others of their lives, then memoir is a profound, even deeply spiritual, venture.
