Over the next few months, we'll be gathering your thoughts and ideas, synthesizing those ideas into a plan, and then implementing that plan.

The Board of Trustees and the Committee on Ministry will organize this conversation, but the members will decide the content and the direction. The conversation will take many forms, both formal and informal. Among other things:

- 1. We hope to have at least one guest speaker a month talk about ministry: What it is, how it is accomplished, and so on.
- 2. We plan to devote a brief portion of each week's round table conversation to takeaways from the previous week's service. These discussions will help us to identify and distill the ideas and actions we most want in our religious life.
